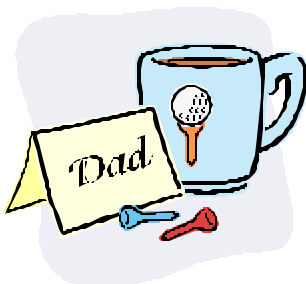
God took....

qualities,

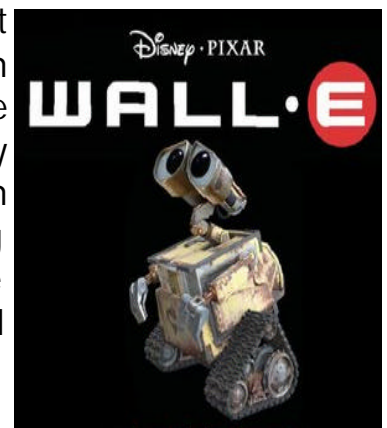

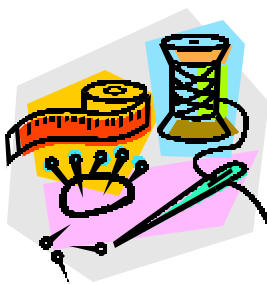
